CONSULTATIVE BALLOT 2014**

Our report of voting for the above ballot, which closed yesterday at noon, is as follows:

Question:

Should BCA, on your behalf, campaign for The Countryside and Rights of Way Act to apply to going underground?

Number of eligible voters:	6,085
Total number of votes cast:	2,270
Turnout:	37.3%
Number of votes found to be invalid:	4
Total number of valid votes to be counted:	2,266

Result

Number voting YES	1,402	(61.9% of the valid vote)
Number voting NO	864	(38.1% of the valid vote)
TOTAL	2,266	(100% of the valid vote)

- a) was sent the details of the ballot and
- b) if they chose to participate in the ballot, had their vote fairly and accurately recorded.
