NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2006

1 Accounting Policies

a) Basis of Accounting

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards and under historical cost accounting rules.

b) Equipment

Equipment is charged in the accounts in the year of purchase.

c) Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

2 Additional Notes

- a) The British Caving Association (BCA) has promised to refund the difference between £18 & £6 for those persons who had joined BCA as CIM's by more than one club. This has not been undertaken during 2005 and therefore remains as a creditor. BCA has identified that some further duplicate payments in 2006 were not dealt with. An additional £100 has been added to the existing £7,200 to cover this new liability.
- **b)** BCA is required to cover part of the insurance policy excess itself, in order to make membership attractive. This cover is provided by the 'sinking fund'. BCA Council has made a decision on how this fund should be held which is now being implemented.
