NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2008

1 Accounting Policies

a) Basis of Accounting

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards and under historical cost accounting rules.

b) Equipment

Equipment is charged in the accounts in the year of purchase.

c) Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

2 Additional Notes

- a) The British Caving Association (BCA) has promised to refund the difference between £18 & £6 for those persons who had joined BCA as CIM's by more than one club. The 2009 AGM resolved that this matter has been persued as far as possible. Anyone who believes they are still due a refund should apply to the Membership Administrator.
- b) BCA is required to cover part of the insurance policy excess itself, in order to make membership attractive. This is the purpose of the 'sinking fund'.
