Keeping your online club membership list up to date

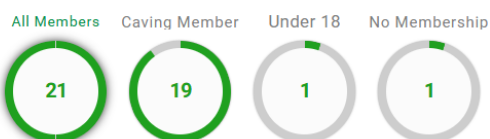
